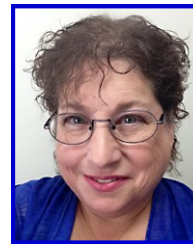

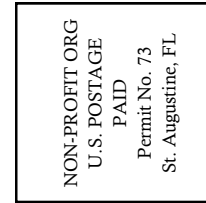
PLANNING AHEAD
